Tapestry Learning Journal Downloads

Dear Reception Parents/Carers,

As the end of term is upon us, we have now stopped uploading pictures and videos onto your child's Tapestry account.

A PDF copy of your child's learning journal is now available for you to download at home. We strongly recommend that you download your child's journal **as soon as possible**, as Tapestry deletes journals 30 days after they have been converted into PDF formats.

Please find a letter attached which shows you step- by- step instructions on how to do this. Please also note, that downloads can only happen via the Tapestry website and not via the app.

We hope you have enjoyed receiving updates on your child's learning experiences in Cherry class throughout the year.

Please come and see me if you are having difficulties downloading your child's learning journey.

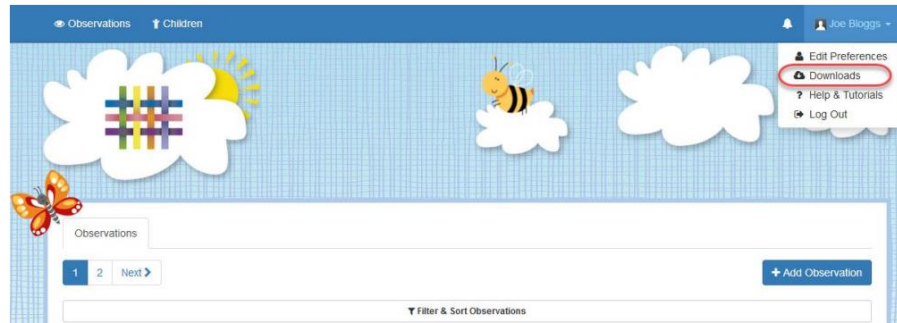

How to download your child's Learning Journal

Step 1: Log into Tapestry using the web browser version through our login page at <https://tapestryjournal.com/>.

Step 2: Click on your username at the top right of the screen and select 'Downloads' from the drop down list.



Step 3: On the Downloads page you should see all downloads you have available. Click the 'Download' button to download your PDF copy of the journal or ZIP file of the media.

Make sure you save your files somewhere safe and if possible save it to permanent storage off your PC (such as a CD or external hard drive), marking it so you will be able to find it in the future. Remember, Tapestry records will usually be deleted once your child has left!

You can print off a copies of the PDF journal and the pictures if you like. If you don't have a printer (or access to one you frequently use), you could try your local library, print shop, or look online - although we don't recommend any specific company, there are quite a few out there who will professionally print and bind documents and pictures.
