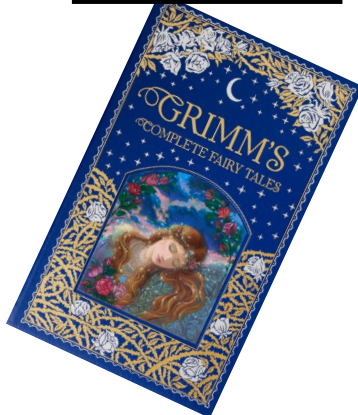

Alice in Wonderland



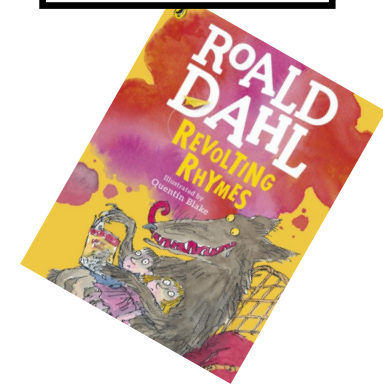
- We will be using 'Wonderland' as more inspiration for creating our own world
