What To Bring:

- Children should be in **full school uniform**, with an outdoor warm coat. The school will take no responsibility for lost items such as gloves or hats.
- Children should bring a healthy packed lunch which includes a sandwich/ pasta salad/wrap etc, with plenty of fluids (no fizzy drinks or glass containers).

We have children with severe allergies to the following items: Nuts (hazelnuts, sesame seeds and peanuts) and Chickpeas. Could we remind you this includes Nutella spread and Bueno bars.
