Costumes

BEN, MAX, SAMANTHA, C-J: School uniform

THE KEYMASTER: dull jacket or dull shirt. Bright jacket or cloak, colourful and/or sparkly.

All other children should wear black top and black trousers, or as dark as possible. This will be complemented by props and accessories as characters change. See below for suggestions:

COMMENTATORS: Big winter coat

WILLIAM/HAROLD: Crowns, toy bow and arrow, whistles,

NORMANS & SAXONS: plastic swords, shields, helmets

DOCTOR: White coat/apron, Tudor plague mask,

PATIENTS: Stick on blisters or similar

GUY FAWKES: Black coat, pointy beard, giant torch (old fashioned flame) or giant matchstick

SERGEANT & SOLDIERS: Plastic Helmets, swords, large white T-shirt, belt

LANDLORD: apron, tea towel, pie dish, tankards, empty beer kegs,

LORD GUTSWORTHY: jacket, ruffled shirt (if possible), top-hat or similar, purse

SERVING MAID: white apron, mop cap

EXCISE MEN: jacket

JIM: flat cap, white shirt

WORKERS: flat caps, shirts

RECRUITERS: Nothing extra

MANAGER: waistcoat, clipboard

BOSES: jackets, top hats

SERVANTS: aprons, broom, dustman and brush, dusters

MINERS: plastic pickaxes, flat caps

CHIMNEY SWEEPS: brooms, brushes, flat caps

WOMEN/SUFFRAGETTS: placards (Vote For Women), sashes in purple, green, white, black, long skirt, hats

MEN: smart clothes, suits, bowler hats 1920s style

POLICEMEN: helmet, police jacket, truncheon

SERGEANT: helmet, police jacket, truncheon, whistle

PHOTOGRAPHER: tweed jacket, old-fashioned camera

REPORTER: Casual jacket, trilby hat, notepad, pen

NEWSPAPER BOY: flat cap, sandwich board which reads 'Government Softens On Votes for Women',

EVACUEE: 1940s style clothes, suitcase, gas mask box, school cap, old fashioned suitcase

CHILDREN: School jumper
